General Competition Rules

- Images and prints entered in competitions must be the authors own work and may not be entered in subsequent club competitions, except in themed, Members Choice, and Interclub competitions.
- All images may be commercially processed
- All official pdi competitions (excluding Members Choice) will be judged by an external judge and given a score out of 20. The judge will also select 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, highly commended and commended.
- All images and prints scoring less than 18 points may be re-entered in one other competition of the members choice.
- All official print competitions (excluding Members Choice) will be judged by an external judge and given a score out of 20. The judge will also select 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, highly commended and commended.
- The themed Ken Hitch trophy (pdi's) will be decided on aggregate scores for both set subjects that are set by the club committee. Members should enter 2 colour and 2 monochrome pdi's
- The new Members Choice end of season print and pdi competitions will require the member to select their favourite colour print and colour/monochrome pdi. This competition will be judged by the membership with each member having 3 votes per category, and members cannot vote for their own work.
- Colour and monochrome definitions as advised by the EAF:
 - *Monochromes – a black and white image or one that has been modified by the addition of a single tone to the entire image*
 - *Colour – all images except those included above are defined as colour images. A black and white image which has been modified by the addition of partial toning or by the addition of one colour to any part of the image*
