PHOTOGRAPHY AT ST IVES PHOTOGRAPHIC CLUB

Last year we celebrated our 50th Anniversary, and the club continues to thrive with new members joining us throughout the season. Our members contribute a diverse range of images to our regular competitions, and increasingly we are seeing the creativity and artistry of photographic interpretation, alongside a more traditional approach.

We are an active and friendly club with meetings held from September to April at St Ives Free Church on Tuesday evenings. We meet at 7.30pm for an 8pm start. During the summer we have a programme based mainly outdoors, which last year included nature walks, house and garden visits, botanical gardens, a visit to photograph white water rafting, air shows and more. These outings present a great opportunity to visit new places as well as to take photographs and share knowledge with like-minded people.

Our winter programme is a mix of competitions, talks (some on-line) and practical sessions as well as critique evenings. Talks this season have been on a wide range of subjects, including "Architecture", "Night Photography", "Wildlife" and "Creative Inspiration" as well as talks from our own members on their photographic experiences. We are looking forward to our next event "Getting it right in the Camera" by Richard Houghton on 14th March. This is a fun practical session. The full programme of events is on our website.

In November we hold our Annual Exhibition, where members have the opportunity to display their best images. The exhibition is open to the public, who can vote for their favourite image. The event is one of the highlights of our calendar and it is always great to see members of the public enjoying the exhibits and this often results in a surge in our membership.
